for King County Jail Clearance

Where: Lake Forrest Park Towne Center, 17171 Bothell Way NE, Seattle, WA 98155 (In the food court - same as building as Third Place Books.

When: Saturday. From 10am to 12 noon.

What to Bring:

- 1) A good quality clear color copy of your driver's license or identification.
- 2) The names, addresses and phone numbers for at least two personal character references - not relatives - you have known for 5 years or more..
- 3) ****** See note below regarding criminal records. **YOU MAY WANT TO BRING AN OFFICAL PRINTED RECORD TO MAKE THIS PROCESS MUCH EASIER.**
- 4) Your favorite pen and a pencil.

We will Provide:

- 1) Printed out application packets.
- 2) Help filling them out.

**** An excerpt from King County's instructions on filling the jail clearance application:**

"INCLUDE ALL prior criminal incidents such as arrests, convictions, parole/probation served and community service hours. You MUST include ALL legal incidents, dismissed incidents/charges, legal orders, and juvenile records, with corresponding dates with each incident. The background process may uncover items that have been sealed, dismissed, stricken or expunged. Disclosing these items will not necessarily result in a denied access, though failure to disclose those items WILL result in a denied access.

If necessary, retrieve a detailed printout of your criminal record in Washington and any state across the United States, if applicable. You may go to the King County – Municipal, District and Superior Court Clerks for assistance on King County matters.

Please note: An arrest or conviction will not necessarily result in denied access. Withholding information, or failure to disclose information, WILL result in denied access."

King County Jail - Men and Women H & I Speakers & Panel Leaders Needed!!

Seattle Area Narcotics Anonymous (N.A.) Hospital and Institution (H & I) sub-committee is seeking volunteers speakers and panel leaders for the King County (KC) Men and Women's Jail located in downtown Seattle.

You must meet this requirement FIRST:

Experience attending other NA Hospital and Institution meetings either as speaker or panel leader. Read the Seattle Area NA meeting schedule for more detailed information on how, when, and where to get orientated to volunteer for H & I.

I have H & I experience, now what?

You must meet KC's requirements which is an entirely different thing than NA's guidelines.

King County Jail Clearance Requirements (NOT N.A.'s!!!)

Their words as follows - (NOT N.A.'s):

Please inform ALL prospective NA volunteers who you recruit to volunteer at KCCF of the following DAJD policy, specific to **both HARD and SOFT drug use**, including drug offence(s) both felony and misdemeanor, drug use, drug distribution, drug selling, drug manufacturing, arrests, bookings, detainment, incarceration, probation, parole, court hearings / appearances, and the year(s) for each separate drug related incident(s), that the DAJD clearance Guidelines clearly state:

- A) You are required to have a minimum period of **3 years clean** from your last drug offence on record, or from when you **stopped using soft drugs such as marijuana, hashish, glue sniffing / snuffing, etc.**
- B) You are required to have a minimum period of **7 years clean** from your last drug offence on record, or from when you **stopped using hard drugs such as heroin, meth, crack cocaine, etc.**
- C) You may re-apply again as an NA Volunteer after you meet, and satisfy the **minimum requirements for hard drug offence / use (7 years squeaky clean), and soft drug offence / use (3 years squeaky clean).**

Please note the difference between **Hard Drugs and Soft Drugs. You must be released from probation for 3 years before applying for jail access as a volunteer.**

ALL other Arrests, Convictions, Warrants Served, No Contact Orders, Sexual Harassment Charges, Domestic Violence Charges, CITATIONS, MUST be noted on the application, even if you don't think they matter. Disclose everything upfront, or they are likely to refuse your application. If you really can't remember details, say so. "Various small offences between year x and year y", forgotten details... say something. Don't look like you're trying to hide anything.
