



## **SAASC/SASC EVENT LIABILITY WAIVER**

**I, the undersigned, hereby state that I wish to participate in activities offered by SEATTLE AREA NARCOTICS ANONYMOUS & SEATTLE AREA ACTIVITIES SUB-COMMITTEE (HEREIN REFERRED TO AS SASC & SAASC), A 12-step organization and sub-committee.**

**I recognize that any activity may involve certain dangers, including but not limited to the hazards of physical injury, accidents of illnesses in remote places, forces of nature, and the actions of participants and other persons.**

**I fully recognize that hiking, volleyball and other activities offered by SASC/SAASC have the potential to be VERY DANGEROUS, and participation involves risks and dangers that may result in SERIOUS INJURY, PARALYSIS, DISABILITY, or DEATH.**

**I further understand and agree that without some program providing protection to its leaders, SASC/SAASC would not be able to offer these activities.**

**In consideration of the right to participate in the activities offered by SASC/SAASC, I agree to RELEASE, HOLD HARMLESS, AND INDEMNIFY SASC/SAASC and its members from any and all liability, claims and causes of action arising out of or in any way connected with my participation, or the participation of any minor that I am signing on behalf of, in any activities offered by SASC/SAASC. I personally assume all risks in connection with these activities. IF I am signing on behalf of a minor, I further agree to HOLD HARMLESS, AND INDEMNIFY SASC/SAASC and its members from all liability, claims and causes of action which the minor may have arising from the minor's participation in activities.**

**The terms of this agreement shall serve as a release and indemnity agreement for my heirs, personal representative, and for all members of my family, including any minors. (Parents or legal guardians must sign for all persons under eighteen (18) years of age.)**
