I have brought 24 physical copies of this SASC Treasurer Report and March financial statement for distribution. I will review the financial statement after I finish reading this report. As always, these reports will be posted to the SeattleNA.org website by our beloved web coordinator.

2. At the March meeting of this SASC, I distributed the February financial statement and it had an error. Our mistake was that we reported \$683 of Unity Day income as Group Donations income. We have corrected these numbers in the February column of the financial statement that we are distributing today.

3. In March the Vice-Chair (Jake H) and I met with the bank to have him added as a signer on the bank account and the former Chair (William C) removed.

4. In March at the request of the schedules coordinator we paid an invoice for \$734.36 for the printing of 2016-Q2 Meeting Schedules. Normally we would not pay this invoice until April. (We paid for 2016-Q1 Meeting Schedules in January). This resulted in our overspending our 2016-Q1 PR budget and overspending our 2016-Q1 overall admin budget by \$229.17. This resulted in our having no excess funds in 2016-Q1. I will have a conversation with the schedules coordinator to establish whether this earlier payment was intended as a one-time matter or as the new normal.

5. With regard to our initiative to have our Seattle International Narcotics Anonymous Convention (SINAC) routinely report their finances to this SASC, you will recall that we failed to come to an agreement. There has been no activity on this matter from me this month.

6. With regard to our initiative to have this SASC become capable to accept Payment Card (PC) payments. You will recall that on our meeting of March 6th 2016 this body approved a motion that authorized me to sign contracts to make this happen. Today I can report that contracts have been signed. Electronic copies of the contracts have been provided to the SASC Secretary and the other SASC Officers for our records. I have received the equipment and the training and I have run some test transactions. I will meet with the Assistant Treasurer and Unity Day committee in the coming week. We are optimistic that we will be accepting Payment Card payments at Seattle Area Unity Day on April 16, 2016.

7. With regard to Activities subcommittee making and reporting their deposits in accordance with our guidelines. The deposit for the Egg Hunt was a couple of days late. I have spoken with the Activities Committee Chair and Treasurer. They acknowledge the issue and will take corrective action.

8. I will now review the financial statement.
