As mentioned, last months minutes are not up to date but will be soon. This was due to a lack of coordination, partially on my end. There were a lot of GSRs here last month but I didn't get very many group reports. If you're here please fill out a report and leave it with me.

*I am pleased to introduce Brenda D. who was elected as the SASC Assistant Treasurer at our last meeting. Please have your group donations submitted before the break.*

1. I have brought a couple of dozen hard copies of the financial report for July 2015. As we always do, these reports will also be posted on the SeattleNA.org website. Is there any GSR present who wants me to take a few minutes now and talk us through these numbers?
2. As I reported last month, in my review of the files I noticed that it is our tradition to have the SASC officers sign a Memorandum of Financial Responsibility. We have clarified this situation and determined that the SASC Chairperson is responsible to obtain and retain these documents. Therefore I turned over those documents that we had in the Treasurer files to William our Chairperson.
3. Our SASC guidelines call for an Audit either annually, or whenever we get a new Treasurer. The audit was conducted on Sunday July 19th at the home of Robyn A the former Treasurer of SASC. Members present for the Audit were William our Chairperson, Joe B the Activities Treasurer, Mike L the SASC Treasurer and Robyn A the former Treasurer.
4. There were no adverse findings as a result of the audit. There were however a couple of routine matters. First, there was a check written and cashed for 70 dollars instead of 17 dollars. I am happy to report that since the audit the error of 53 has been refunded to SASC. Second, there were three checks that are now stale. That is – they were written over 6 months ago and have never been cashed. The total of these three checks was \$35.99. At the request of the payees, this money has now been returned to SASC available funds.
5. As previously reported, in June we had an unusually large bank adjustment of exactly \$160 for the literature deposit. This has been reported to the Literature Committee and they are investigating.
6. Since my last report I received a Category Summary of Money In and Money Out from SINAC. It did not however report any balances. I will work with their officers to obtain this additional information and make SINAC finances part of our routine monthly reporting.
