Hello Everyone,

I know it seems like a long time since the 4th of July Picnic but I just want to say that it was by far the best one yet! I smiled all day. The activities committee had tons of support both as a committee and from the fellowship. It really was a joy from set up to clean up. Ray and I deposited \$2406.93 on the 4th of July. I have completed the Event Accountability Form for the event and am turning it in to the treasurer today. Our costs to put on the event totaled 1306.33 and we had donations the day of event totaling 1965.51 and we had unused advanced funds in the amount of 441.42. It was a successful event with excess funds of 1100.60

We had the Cherry Hall Dance on Saturday, 7-09 and unfortunately did not have enough attendance to cover our costs of 180.00. I deposited 92.00 on July 11th, the event had a shortfall of 88.00. We have as a committee decided to suspend the monthly dances for now and maybe revisit the subject again in the fall.

Recovery by the River tickets sales are starting to heat up and I deposited 565.00 on July 18th.. I made an additional deposit on 8-05 in the amount of 1035.00. I am turning in an additional 415.00 today, bringing total deposits to date of 2240.00. .

Our region donated about \$15,300 to world for the 2nd quarter, which is awesome. We had a small discussion about how we as areas get out subcommittee chairs to attend all-subcs – which if you recall, is ironic because we just had that conversation here not 6 months ago.

Here are the few things left that I want to let everyone know about:

1. World Wide Unity Day is on September 3rd at 10AM PST. See www.na.org for more info.
2. Elections will be held at region and at all-subcs during October RSC. Open positions are
 - a. Regional Chair and Vice Chair
 - b. Regional PI Chair
 - c. Regional Secretary and Secretary Trainee
 - d. Regional activities vice chair
 - e. Regional Literature vice chair
 - f. Regional IT vice chair

All of those will be held on the Saturday before 10AM

I will reiterate the 3 issue discussion topics that Bill brought up because these are important things that would do our fellowship good to start thinking about.

1. Atmosphere of Recovery in Service
2. Applying Our Principles to Technology and Social Media
3. How to use: "Guiding Principles: The Spirit of Our Traditions"

It is our thoughts that as RCM's it is our job to get this information out to the area. These issue discussion topics are not put out to generate a "yes or no" or a "right or wrong" answer, but more to help bring about a state of mindfulness to the fellowship. We are hoping that as we discuss these topics that it will be a fun and enlightening experience for everyone!

Lastly, I want to encourage anyone who wants to come to region next quarter to talk to me or Bill at some time as we would love to have you join us at RSC. My first regional experience was with 6 months clean, just going with a friend, and I was truly blown away at some of the things that were being discussed. I strongly encourage the younger members to attend and it can help generate a healthy mindset for service.

RCM 2:

RCM II Report to Aug 2016 SASC

Steve and I attended the July 2016 RSC meeting in Ellensburg on July 8 and 9. Our RD team Bonner and George gave a presentation on their experience at the weeklong World Service Conference in April. We are looking at a worldwide fellowship that is progressively more international in scope. Because of that, the WSC in the next 2 years will be looking at the representational protocol at the WSC that might better reflect our international diversity while at the same time not negatively impact the regional structure that is in place. One of the 6 Projects scheduled for the next 2 years is entitled The Future of the WSC. Others are Service Tools, Fellowship Development and PR Project Plan, Collaboration in Service, Social Media as a PR Tool and Recovery Lit Project Plans (for 2018).

We also engaged in several roundtable discussions at Region with the RD team where we were introduced to the 3 Issue Discussion Topics for the next 2 years:

1. Atmosphere of Recovery in Service
2. Applying Our Principles to Technology and Social Media
3. How to use: "Guiding Principles: The Spirit of Our Traditions"

We also received the results of our Membership Survey with a record 22,803 participants. A few notable highlights: average age of members is 48, average cleantime is 8.32 years, and 46% heard of NA from a treatment professional.

In the spirit of participation from our Area, Steve and I have talked about initiating a series of ongoing discussions of the suggested issued discussion topics. We thought we'd start small by using some open sharing time and maybe build up to separately scheduled discussions outside of Area, depending on the interest.

At the April WSC, a member of our Region, Jack H of Bellingham, your Regional C&E Chair, was elected to the World Board, joining another member of our Region on that body, Franny J from Olympia.

Also, at the RSC, we were informed that the 2018 WNIRCNA will be in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. (2017 is at the SeaTac Marriott, site of the just completed, very successful, I might say, Seattle International NA Convention). By the way, thanks to all of you who made SINAC happen.

And thanks to all who worked on and attended Clean and Free by the Sea 2016 – the event netted \$29,000 for the Region. A lot of that money will be moved on to the World Service Conference to be used for all their ongoing projects.

We passed a motion at RSC: Amend RSC Guidelines to change language to Alternate Delegate (AD) from Regional Delegate Alternate (RDA). In keeping with the more common language in other regions. So now the RD team is composed of the RD and AD, Regional Delegate and Alternate Delegate.

A recommendation out of Region is that any Area Subcommittee Chairs or Coordinators upon election contact their respective Chair at the Region (e.g. newly elected Activities Chair make contact with the Regional Activities Chair). This is to assist the Regional Subcommittee Chairs to be a better resource to the Area subcommittees in our Region.

In closing, I'd like to mention that there are flyers on the table for the Summer Sizzlers 3-day event in Tri-Cities on Aug 19-21, which is only 2 weeks away.
