Treasurer:

1. We balanced the ledger to the bank statement for July 2017, with the exception of the amount for check# 9124 - the bank deposited the check for \$13.47, but the check was written for \$13.42. This is a difference of \$0.05, and I still have not had time to follow-up with the bank.
2. In May, we reported bank posted a correction of \$277.64 to our account as an adjustment. I have been able to determine, based on the checks and cash count from May, that this was due to a math error on our part in filling out the deposit slip. Basically, the checks were including both in the amount listed as cash on the deposit slip, as well as being listed under checks on the deposit slip, and so were double counted. When I add up the checks for May, the total is \$278.64 in checks. When I subtract that number from the cash listed on the deposit slip, the number matches exactly what the bank had for our deposit for May. I apologize for the error and the confusion it has caused. I have put a written report detailing the math into the May financials, and am happy to submit this with my report via email this month.
3. I will be emailing copies of this report and the statement for July 2017 for posting online.
4. I am now going to read the statement for July 2017.

RCM Report to August 2017 SASC

Since our last Area meeting, Steve and I attended the July 14/15 RSC. I haven't received the minutes from that meeting, but I will report on the highlights.

We flew up the San Diego RD named Dave T, 35 years clean, 34 years NA service experience to conduct the RSC inventory. The main focus turned out to be how we run our meeting and what the problems were in the RSC 2-day event. Dave began by asking what people didn't like about what was going on at the meeting. Issues like too much sidetalk, overly lengthy reports, inattentiveness among the members and lack of RCM training were the main topics.

Dave had us vote and we ended up focusing mainly on inattentiveness/sidetalk disruption and RCM training. Our solution to the first was putting in our format, minimize the sidetalk, if you engage in sidetalk, you will be reminded and please respond by saying, "I'm sorry and thanks for reminding me." That quickly became our mantra and turned a problem into a fun reminder. ON the training, we kicked it around for awhile and ended up with chair agreeing to meet with new RCM 1's and 2's 15 minutes before the Friday night session.
