On January 8th and 9th, Steve and I attended the Regional Service Committee (RSC) in Ellensburg, WA. We were given an extensive presentation from the Regional Delegate and Regional Delegate Alternate (RD Team) about upcoming World Service Conference motions to be decided in California in April 2016.

Today, Steve and I will give brief instructions on how to take your groups through the process of both the Fellowship Survey and the Conference motions. Please note that we need to have the survey results handed in at March SASC. The motions can also be submitted at March area, but if you run into problems, you can submit those in April.

On January 10th, our Area hosted the RD team presentation of CAR motion in this room. We had about 50 in attendance. We met for 3-4 hours and had very informative discussions about the motions.
