1. I have brought 24 physical copies of this SASC Treasurer Report and December financial statement for distribution. In addition this month we are distributing copies of the 2015 Group Donations Report. I have asked our newly elected assistant Treasurer Tony T. to explain the Group Donations Report. We ask that you take copies back to your group. Broad distribution of these reports is an essential part of ensuring transparency and accountability for NA funds. As always, these reports will be posted to the SeattleNA.org website by our beloved web coordinator.

2. You will notice that December was the end of the fourth quarter (Q4 2015). So we have calculated our excess funds for the quarter (after setting aside prudent reserves). We have \$1,389.08 in excess funds. From these funds 65% (\$902.90) are available today for project based spending. All excess funds that are not set aside for project based spending during our meeting today will be contributed to WNIR (Washington Northern Idaho Region) and WSO (NA World Service Organization) later today.

3. You may notice that the Activities Committee balance was not reset to their prudent reserve level of \$2,000. This is because their deposit from the New Years Eve dance was made on January 1st so it is not shown on the December report, and that deposit is more than enough to restore them to their prudent reserve level going into Q1 2016.

4. With regard to our initiative to have our Seattle International Narcotics Anonymous Convention (SINAC) routinely report their finances to this SASC, I regret to report that we have failed to come to an agreement.

5. With regard to our initiative to have this SASC become capable to accept Payment Card (PC) payments. You will recall that in October a motion was put forward but this was later withdrawn because it was not properly formed. In October this SASC established an ad hoc committee to work on the matter and put forward a well formed motion. You will recall that in November that ad hoc committee put forward a motion which has been distributed in the minutes. That motion was tabled to provide time for folks to consider the matter. You will recall that in December a second ad hoc committee was established to work on this matter. It is my understanding that the second ad hoc committee has not yet met.

6. I will now review the financial statement.
I thank you for allowing me to be of service. I will now take your questions.

I appreciate everyones cooperation in doing this since there are groups with similar names.
