Hi family.

Your RCM team went to Region this weekend. I've gotta say, there are some really amazing people in service within our fellowship. It's a real gift to be able to follow in the footsteps of some of these members. It is still amazing to me how much work we, as a fellowship, get done over the course of a day and a half. The main focus of the weekend seemed to be on what C&E was doing to make themselves more "transparent." Jack H. from Bellingham gave a great presentation on what C&E is and how it came about. They are putting in a lot of work to clean up / or adjust the guidelines to make them more suitable for today's business. This is a long and slow process that will take many quarters to complete. C&E made one motion to the Regional body. Basically the motion was to change from check signing to a check stamping system with their bank accounts. The reason for this motion is that in today's world the banks are requiring all signers to be present at one bank at the same time which given the size of our area and the amount of check signers (11+/-) is a difficult task. Using one FSA stamp will help the C&E body to function more smoothly. The motion passed with the region.

Our RDs showed us some cool video's, including one emphasizing the work being done in the European Delegates Meeting (EDM), which is a zonal forum over in Europe. It was a really cool video and pretty inspiring. This quarter, the RDs rotated out. Nick H. completed his term and Bonner stepped up into the RD position. We had an open discussion on presenting the CAR report next year. The idea behind it was to change the way we gather a collective conscious for the region. The RD's would do four presentations in the months of February and March, splitting the region into four zones. GSR's and other interested members would attend these CAR presentations in order to collectively come up with a conscious.
