## **RCM:**

RCM Report to July 2017 SASC

What's up, Seattle Area?

On June 17, I attended the Relationship Workshop. I liked the layout: workshops in different rooms, lots of room to find a seat, and the main social gathering space with tables and chairs to gather around and rap and eat and hang out. Liked the free appetizers, particularly the veggies and cheese for a healthier alternative. Lots of water and other drink options for sale for cheap. The workshop speakers were outstanding and the final duo main speaker tandem Chucky and Nature hit it out of the park. A good time was had by all. All, that is, who attended. Don't have exact numbers, but maybe a fluctuating population of 50 – 75 at any given time during the four hours, doubt if ever 100 in the building at once. I talked to Activities Committee members during the event and encouraged them to keep learning and building, that they are new to this latest gig and it takes time, but maybe a smaller event was a blessing since some of the operational pressure was off. I loved the event, thanks Activity Committee.

Steve and I are heading to Regional Service Committee meeting in Ellensburg Friday/Saturday July 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup>. We will be participating in an RSC Inventory. So our Area reports will be submitted to Regional minutes, but not verbally delivered, to make time for inventory. Should be interesting, never have participated in Regional inventory and I have logged at least 8 years there since 1988.

Upcoming RSC will be my last as your RCM. October RSC is attended by new RCM team. I am enjoying it, love working with Steve, and hope Dani sticks with the mentoring process and of course gets elected RCM2 in October as long as that is Seattle Area group conscience. In the meantime, we are gearing up for the CAR

workshops in December (CAR = Conference Agenda Report) to consider the items under consideration for April 2018 World Service Conference. We would like to make a bid for Seattle Area to once again host one of the 4 quadrant RD team led workshops in December. We also usually purchase one report per GSR who attends January 2018 Area (maybe \$11 each) as well as rent a facility for 4 hours or so. Last time we rented this facility and had good overall turnout, but I believe we only had 5 or 6 GSRs from our Area there. Not sure why, but maybe we can spur more interest next time around. Hopefully we were able to put aside some Special Projects money at the Admin meeting held earlier today for all that (maybe 60 X & 11 = \$660 plus \$300 for facility rental plus \$40 copying for total of \$1000 to be set aside for December event). If not available today, another bite of apple in October for Special Projects, since the bid would go in at October RSC which follows our October Area meeting. Whatever we don't use will get sent up to Region eventually regardless.

There are 3 major positions open at RSC. Alternate Delegate (AD), analogous to our RCM 2. AD to RD like RCM2 to RCM. Goes to World Service Conference every 2 years with RD to represent Washington Northern Idaho Region. (next one is April 2018). I know of 2 strong candidates that are interested in this position. 4-year commitment, 2 as AD, 2 as RD. The other 2 positions are RSC Treasurer and RSC Treasurer Trainee. Both are interim positions, as both previous members resigned in middle of terms. Both are 1-year terms, probably 9 month interim. There are people to help train you if you are interested. The job is similar in scope to our Seattle Area Treasurer job in terms of transactions, but once a quarter, not monthly like Area.
