1. I have brought 30 physical copies of this SASC Treasurer Report and May financial statement for distribution. As always, these reports will be posted to the SeattleNA.org website by our beloved web coordinator. I will now review the financial statement in detail.
2. With regard to our initiative to have our Seattle International Narcotics Anonymous Convention (SINAC) routinely report their finances to this SASC, you will recall that we failed to come to an agreement. There has been no activity on this matter from me this month.
3. This is my final SASC meeting as your Treasurer. It has been a good experience and I thank you for allowing me to be of service. At the appropriate time in our agenda today, I will nominate Tony T our current Assistant Treasurer to become our new Treasurer. You may recall that Tony does not have the benefit of serving a full year as Assistant Treasurer, so his training was somewhat reduced. Nevertheless I think he will do a fine job and I will continue to assist him informally over the next month or two if he wants any help.

4. The SASC guidelines require us to perform a financial Audit at least once per year and every time there is a change of Treasurer. RCM 2 Report to June 2016 SASC

Not a lot to report this month. I attended the RD/RD Alt presentation at our Regional Convention about how our NA Fellowship is emphasizing ways to protect our copyrighted material by each of us standing up for our Fellowship when the situation presents itself. They told us about conflict resolution principles where a group problem is solved at the group or the Area, Area problem at Area or Region, Regional problem at Region.

Quick synopsis of World Service Conference activity: first 3 motions were passed: motion 1, our Traditions workbook is approved; motion 2, World Board configuration, term limits, etc. ; motion 3, World should develop pamphlet on Mental Health Issues. Also, motion 11, seat Zonal Forum representatives at the WSC, with an amendment that it be on a one cycle trial basis.

Also, I had a chance to talk with our RD Alt, soon to become our RD, about gathering a Regional conscience for the April 2018 CAR motions. He is looking at developing a group conscience such that we gather together in larger forums to talk through them all and come to a consensus there, rather than simply inform, send to groups and gather votes. I had shared some of the concerns we had at our Area about having more involvement and more of a widely informed consensus. Our Area didn't do as well as some, probably did better than most. Thank you all for your patience and participation.
