1. I have brought 24 physical copies of this SASC Treasurer Report and February financial statement for distribution. I will review the financial statement after I finish reading this report. As always, these reports will be posted to the SeattleNA.org website by our beloved web coordinator.
2. You will recall that at our meeting (on January 3rd 2016) I was instructed to set aside \$550.00 for purchases of NA Basic Texts to be donated. This purchase was made by the PR Committee in February, so you will see that the PR expense is unusually large in February.
3. With regard to our initiative to have our Seattle International Narcotics Anonymous Convention (SINAC) routinely report their finances to this SASC, you will recall that we failed to come to an agreement. There has been no activity on this matter from me this month.
4. With regard to our initiative to have this SASC become capable to accept Payment Card (PC) payments. You will recall that on our meeting of February 7th 2016 a motion was put forward by the ad hoc committee and it was taken back to the home groups for consideration. It is my understanding that we will vote on that motion later today. I support that motion and I am prepared to make it happen if it is approved.
5. When I review the financial statement for February you will notice that the Activities subcommittee has zero income. The reason for this is because the income from the second Saturday dance was not deposited until after March 1st. This is contrary to the guidelines for that subcommittee. I have spoken with the Activities Committee Chair and Treasurer. They acknowledge the mistake and will take corrective action.
6. I had the great pleasure to attend the Seattle Area Second Saturday Dance in February and want to congratulate the Activities Committee for a wonderful event. If you have not yet been to one of these dances I highly recommend that you attend. It is great fun in recovery.
7. During the February Second Saturday Dance, a raffle was conducted that was not for the benefit of NA, it was for the benefit of the facility. Perhaps this raffle was not in perfect accord with our 6th and 7th Traditions. I have spoken with the Activities Committee Chair and he agrees that there is reason for concern. He has assured me that the committee will review these Traditions at their next meeting and ensure that all their activities are conducted in accordance with the NA Traditions.
