1. I have brought 30 copies of the financial statement for September 2015. The financial statement and this Treasurer Report will be posted on the SeattleNA.org website.

2. I regret to report that our Assistant Treasurer has resigned. I want to thank Brenda D for her service and especially for showing up today to help with the counting. I ask all SASC members to spread the word that we are in need of a replacement. This is a matter of great urgency since the training period for the assistant is normally from July 1 to December 31.

3. With regard to Seattle International Narcotics Anonymous Convention (SINAC) you will recall that we are attempting to ensure that SINAC finances are routinely reported to this SASC. This month we made good progress in this matter and you will find those Bank Balances reported in the financial statement for the start of (fourth quarter) Q4-2015 which began on October 1st, 2015.

4. With regard to SASC becoming able to accept card payments, you will recall that I have been instructed to work with Heidi C. the Unity Day chair to figure out how to make this happen. I have made a number of inquiries and have learned that in order to make this happen the SASC will need to sign a contract with a Merchant Services Processor. If this SASC want the Treasurer to sign the contract on behalf of SASC, then specific authorization from this Committee is required. I suggest that we probably want to appoint some members to review the contract before I sign it on our behalf. Some of the terms and conditions in the contract are optional/negotiable I ask for your authorization to negotiate the contract. The Merchant Services Processor requires a physical address for the Merchant (us) and they require a physical site visit by one of their representatives. Our PO Box is not acceptable for this purpose. The home address of the Treasurer is acceptable but I would require authorization from this Committee for that purpose. We need to decide what text is to appear on peoples card statements when they make a purchase. It is my understanding that purchasers have 90 days (from the date of their statement) to dispute charges. We need to decide who within the SASC is responsible for those disputes.

Clearly we have not figured out all the details yet. I have spoken with the Unity Day chair on this matter as recently as this morning. We are both committed to working together to figure out how to allow SASC to accept card payments.

**RCM 2:**

First of all, I would like to thank this body for the incredible show of support last month upon election to this position. I've never felt so much acceptance and encouragement when elected to any NA position.

During the month I have been in several discussions with RCM Steve and brainstormed about upcoming events. I feel we are establishing a good working relationship, important in this job which particularly lends itself to a 2 person team effort. I also talked to Activities Vice Chair and Area Treasurer. I intend to go to some subcommittees and Admin meeting previous to today's Area meeting. In the next 6 months, we are charged with gathering the Area conscience for all matters to be considered at the World Service Conference, held every two years to decide Fellowship wide issues. The Conference Agenda Report will be available to the Fellowship at na.org on November 25, 2015. The RD and RD Alt will school us at Jan 2016 RSC. The Regional conscience will be compiled at Apr 2016 RSC. In light of this, Steve and I are asking for \$750 to be set aside from special projects spending for possible venue rent and purchase of Conference Agenda Reports. Since we don't know yet when our meetings might be, whether we can possibly piggyback onto Regional presentations where they would fund or how much the materials might cost (some years \$11.00 X 50 = \$550) and possible \$200 venue rent, say Lake City Community Center once or twice. So far, semi-educated guesswork, but needed to request funds to be spent from Jan 2016 to Apr 2016 at today's admin meeting before we even know much about what is going on. Trying to do our job, be fully transparent and proactive at the same time, some juggling.

Today I wanted to appeal directly to the GSRs that the groups in this matter, per 12 Concepts, are the final decision-making authority. I want to appeal to you that my aim is to afford every opportunity to be involved in this upcoming process and yet also allow each group to pursue their own course. In the Conference Agenda Report, you might have a pamphlet for up or down vote. But you might have 5 options to choose from on upcoming lit projects and be asked to rate importance from 1-5.

Or we might have some proposed service structure ideas: what do you like and what do you dislike, with accompanying feedback. Bottom line: will all happen between Jan RSC and Apr RSC.

Thanks again for giving me this opportunity to be of service.
