RCM Report to Sept 2017 SASC

I was very grateful to our Area Admin Jake and Mike and Kiara that we were able to have our SASC meeting last month on 8/13 at Edmonds Lutheran Church. I feel like the meeting was vital to maintain our continuity as a functioning ASC. Thanks for making that happen.

On 8/5, I attended the end of Phoneline/H&I Orientation and a bit of the PR Committee. It was apparent that our trusted servants in that line of service were very actively responding to concerns that had been raised concerning our Phoneline calls being answered. Thank you to our servants for addressing that. I have had some in depth conversations with George BH, RD from our Region, Alan B, former Seattle Area Web Coordinator (in fact, created our Area website originally) and Matthew, our present Seattle H&I Coordinator. I also had sent a detailed email to Eric the Phoneline Coordinator to which he promptly replied (thanks Eric) and talked to Ben PR Chair as well as briefly to Jim former PR Chair. I am very encouraged that we are addressing concerns.

I am greatly looking forward to the SINAC Salmon Bake and Dessert Auction on 9/23 at this very church starting @ 3 pm. Two very dear friends are the speakers, George BH and Becky W. Also, fresh salmon and 2 major raffle drawings, 1 for charter fishing trip and one for Seahawk tickets. \$20 for dinner. Couldn't get that at any reputable seafood restaurant.

My term is running toward a close. Next month is my last Area in this position. I have much faith in my replacement, Steve F, one, because this is his second time in the position, but second, and more importantly, I have great respect for his knowledge and his dedication and energy he brings to the position. He has been a blast to work with. Also, we have trained a great candidate for RCM2, Dani G. I checked with her just a week ago and she is still very interested. I would nominate her now if the election were today and feel like she has the knowledge and energy to do a great job if she wants to. But the decision is obviously yours to make at next month's October ASC, so if anyone else is interested, feel free to step forward next month and be nominated or even nominate yourself.

When I came into the position almost 2 years ago, we were ready to embark on the upcoming World Service Conference (WSC) 2016 cycle. We were approving The Guiding Principles: The Spirit of Our Traditions book, among other issues. We also had 3 Issue Discussion Topics to discuss: safe atmosphere of recovery in service, the relationship between social media/ technology and our service structure, and using the new Traditions book. Hopefully we addressed those at least to where you have heard of those topics. We did send some input into World on the tech topic, even though there is presently no formal project to revise our pamphlet concerning that subject. But now we are ready to jump off into the 2018 cycle. The Conference Agenda Report (CAR) will be available in late November 2017 for the WSC that will be held in California in early May 2018. That will give us around 5 months to consider and decide on the topics. At the October RSC on October 13/14, we as an Area have to be ready with date, time and location to bid on hosting the quadrant workshop to be held in Seattle Area in December 2017 or January 2018 conducted by our RD team (world delegates from our Region) George

BH from Seattle and Theo from Blue Mountain. Steve and I will address that in coming month. Please help Steve and our new RCM2 conduct a thorough group conscience process on the upcoming issues which will be announced towards the end of November. I am pumped. I love NA Fellowship wide discussions.

Upcoming elections at RSC will be held for Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Asst Sec. Our outgoing RD Bonner asked our Region to back him on his bid to be accepted by the World Human Resource Panel. I will leave that to Steve to sort out at Oct RSC. Regional Service Learning Days will be held at Blue Mountain November 3rd and 4th. It should be very informative. H&I Guidelines and Behind the Walls Project are in the RSC minutes. Also, a full detailed reporting of our Inventory process held on Friday night at last RSC is in the minutes, a good resource for anybody doing Area or Region inventory.
