As for literature orders as of 1:22 PM 1/5 we anticipate 25 Homegroups and 4 Individual order totaling 1485.30 in literature orders received.

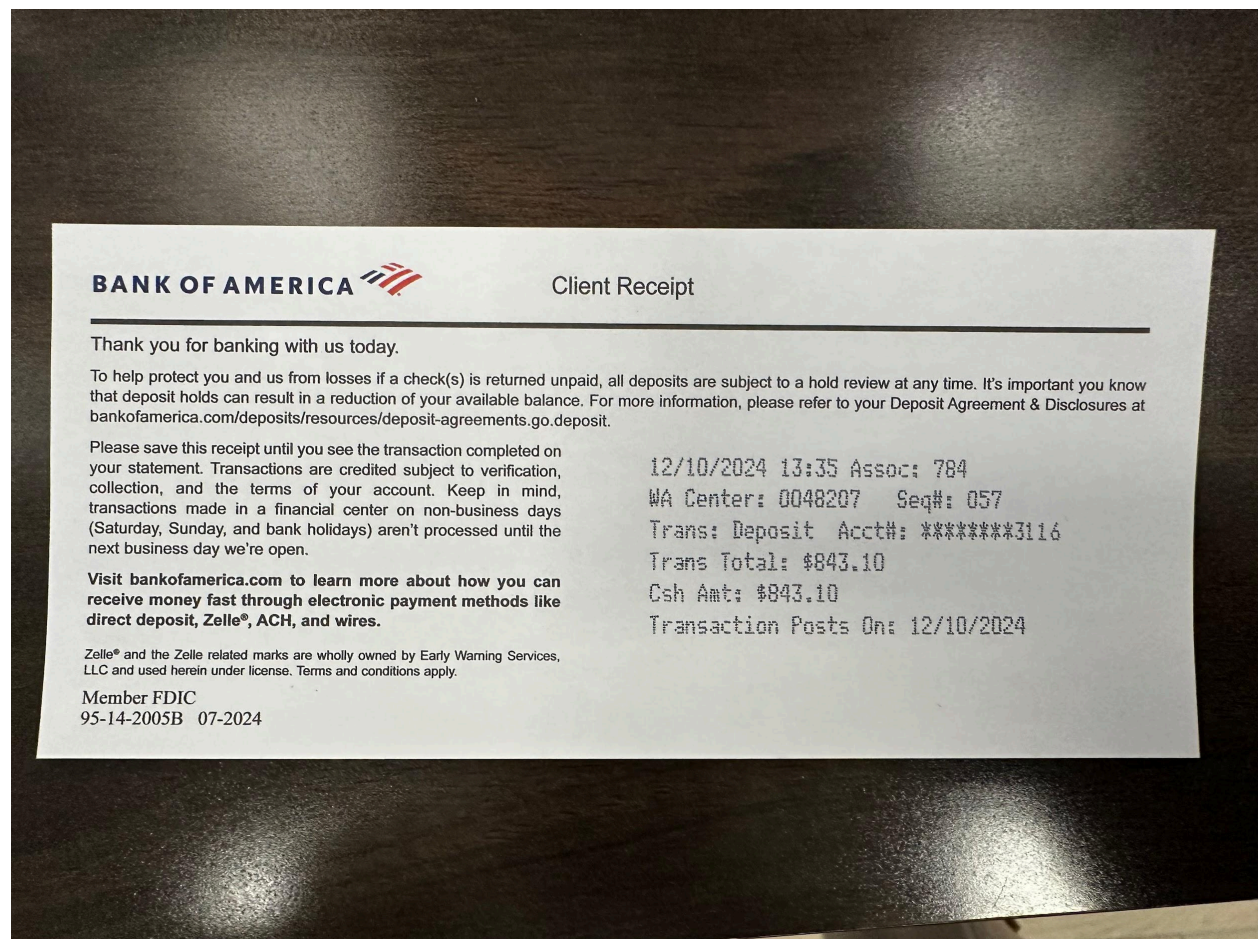
However we should anticipate around 1206.80 in actual sales, given we are short on some items that we didn't receive from NCRSO this month.
