Trusted Servants,

-Please continue to fully identify your Zelle money transfers with purpose; contributions or literature sales, and your group name.

-I met with the Capitol Hill Bank of America, and they ordered us a key for secure night deposits after SASC. We should have the before March SASC. This will allow us to follow our guidelines, depositing all funds after each SASC. That includes Literature sales, any Unity Day money, and group contributions. Depositing requires two trusted servants for safety.

-We received an increase of \$99.00 for our storage unit in December making our rent \$457.00 for a 10 x 10 unit, outside the going rate in Seattle after comparison calls made. Our new contract and our new rate is \$223.00 a month. We will also receive the month of February for \$59.87. This amount had to be paid on site so I will be submitting a request for reimbursement.

Storage Units contracts are month to month, and they can raise them with 30 days' notice. There is a 20x10 available at Extra Space Storage for \$247.00 which is less than they were charging us in 2017. We had previously been there since 2004. The spaces are first come first served and if

we want this space, it may or not still be available. I had reserved it. The reason the 20 x 10 is a better space is because it has two rolling doors making it easier for committees to access their supplies.

What I surmised after review is that the storage industry gamble that their renters are too lazy to move their belongings. New contracts should be negotiated every time an increase is announced.
