- The ledger balance and bank balances did not match for June. The bank on the statement cleared a check originally written in December 2024 and cleared in January 2025, again in June 2025. I will visit the bank upon opening Monday (tomorrow). An additional report will be submitted for inclusion in the minutes.
- The Quarterly reset leaves \$ 10,127.66 available for Project Specific Spending available. Any funds not reserved will be forwarded to Region at the end of Area.
- I have asked Hugs not Drugs to second a motion requesting that the SASC provide vote of confidence and allow me to move our storage unit back to Extra Space Storage from Public Storage. My views and the history of our past experience with Public Storage was spelled out in my Assistant Treasurer report in February 2025. This move will save the fellowship over \$900.00 in the first 6 months. As of June 1<sup>st</sup> Public Storage increased our February contract \$81.00 a month with a proven track record of going much higher.
