PR Report July 27th 2025 (August 2nd ASC)

We need people to be of service with the helpline subcommittee

Sponsorship list- Our Helpline subcommittee is planning to create a list of people willing to be temporary sponsors for people who call the helpline. They will be creating a template and

bringing it to the next PR meeting for approval. If you have any interest in being on this list please let us know.

Packets for frontline workers - at the Regional PR meeting last month some areas reported on some things they're doing to get newcomers to NA. Some of the things they're doing are a bit ambitious for the size of our PR committee and we will reevaluate when we have a PI Chair. One thing they mentioned that we do feel like we can handle is creating little packages that frontline workers can give out to people they encounter in active addiction. This would include EMT's, Police, Hospitals, and Local Community Support Centers. We plan to start with schedules, a couple IP's, and a small card with our and surrounding areas helpline phone numbers and a link to our website. The estimated total cost of this is under \$500.

Our web 1 & 2 have brought us their updated guidelines and we voted to approve them to add zoom meeting coordination for the area to their position responsibilities.

I talked to Alan and he also thinks this a good idea so I thought I'd bring it to the PR subcommittee for discussion and vote and then Area if people think it's a good idea! -Maia

- Service Coverage: With assistance from South King County, now able to provide weekly service at most facilities
- South Seattle Coverage: Improved resource availability with South King County collaboration
 - King County Residential Treatment Program - Pioneer Human Services: 1st and 3rd Wednesdays at 7pm
 - Key Recovery: Mondays at 6:30pm

Budget Report

Literature Expenses - Last 3 Months: Approximately \$300 per quarter (recent order: \$197, ordered bi-monthly) Projected Literature Needs: With planned facility expansions, literature expenses expected to increase to \$400-550 per quarter:

- King County Jail: Significant literature needs once operational (late fall/early winter)
- Lynwood Detox: Anticipated 2-4 panels per week once fully operational
- Seattle Post Acute Care: Monthly panels when service begins in September
