Copies of the 2026 Year-to-Date Group Contribution Report and the March Financial Report are included with this report.

The ledger balance and bank balances match for March along with the financials for SINAC. SINAC's storage was moved March 5<sup>th</sup> with assistance by Johnny Mac, GSR of Hugs not Drugs and Michelle our Fellowship Development chair. Starting in April SINAC will pay ½ of our SASC monthly storage fee of \$242.80, \$121.40..

Unity Day officers were not available at this SASC to arrange for their Unity Day's banking account and their debit card to enable electronic funds handling. This requires a bank visit with all current SASC check signing officers.

We reset the Quarterly Budgets and there was \$1,765.25 in excess funds. After sending off the 10% to World (WSO) and the 25% to Region (WNIR) we had \$1,147.42 for special projects. The remaining was sent the Region at the end of Area.

It has been a long month for PR.

- New schedules have arrived! As usual, please be frugal with them - take what you need. We need to start factoring in additional schedules for H&I.
- Newsletter - will be out at next area.
- We are looking at merging the phonenumber and schedules roles into Member Services. This is because in the old days, phonenumber was manually managed and schedules were as well. Now we have moved to Yap and BMLT which means that the schedules are updated live on the website by web coordinators and it is a one click to send to the printer. Phonenumber is also a lot easier to handle due to Yap. We have sent out notifications to the helpline people to ensure everyone who is on there still is able to be on there and the current schedules work.
- H&I - We have had requests from 3 more venues including an outpatient IOP - Milum in Eastlake. We are discussing having PI take the outpatient clinics and hosting 6 weekly "What is NA sessions" with speakers at these venues as it doesn't fit the charter of H&I (taking meetings to places where people cannot get out) but IS needed to introduce people to NA.
  - We are getting more of these types of requests so we will discuss at H&I how we can handle these through PI.
- PI is hosting a informational table at the Roosevelt high school mental health fair (at their request). We will have IPs and some young (and not so young) people available to answer questions.
- Due to issues with our web hosting moving our website and our backup system not migrating at the same time, we lost everything that had been updated on the website since October last year as that is when they needed to restore to.
  - If you have fliers for upcoming events / calendar items etc, please email [web@seattlena.org](mailto:web@seattlena.org) and we are working to get everything back together.

- This meant that the literature order form got reverted to the old prices - please be nice to the literature team today. The form was recreated with the correct prices 4/10.
- Special projects - Frontline workers packets.
  - This was motioned and budgeted last year Q4, however since the funds were not spent they are now gone. I'm suggesting that instead of a special project we do this as part of PR. We used to deliver schedules by mail to a bunch of hospitals and treatment centers each quarter. We stopped this during COVID. Frontline workers packets can replace that. I'm requesting funds to do 500 packets a quarter to start at a budget of \$350 per quarter. These will consist of a NA business card, schedule and the who, what, how and why IP which is the intro IP to NA for outsiders who may be sceptical of what we do.
  - Books?! No information. Will - see me please.
- H&I currently meets monthly in person at Recovery Cafe. Before COVID, H&I and PR both met there one after the other and we paid \$40 a month rent.
- I am confirming with the treasurer, but it looks like we have not paid rent since COVID, we have just been using our keys and showing up. As per the 7th tradition, we must be fully self supporting declining outside contributions - we owe back rent. I'm reaching out to the facility to discuss either a lump sum payment once we determine how much we owe. We are also looking for a new venue that has parking.
- PR and PI - used to have 2 black totes of IPs, table clothes, banners, IP stands etc. No-one knows what happened to this stuff. It is not in the storage locker - I went and looked. If anyone knows who the past PR chairs have been since 2023 I would love to contact them.
- Zoom! We are paying \$190 a year for zoom (used by everyone). This is normal pricing - not non profit pricing (which is 50% off). I'm going to work with the treasurer on getting us the 503c discount - but I need the paperwork.

Finally - we are requesting \$1390 for the PR budget for Q3.. This includes \$350 for frontline workers packets and \$450 for H&I literature, \$250 for schedules and \$80- for newsletter printing (2 newsletter cycles) and \$40 for general printing for H&I and PR (flyers etc). I compared with our 2022 budgets and we have not actually increased our budget in 4 years - except the addition of newsletter and zoom. Please see the full budget below.
