Date: January 4th 2026 (December Closing)

- Copies of the Year-to-Date Group Contribution Report and the final December Financial Report are available to review and will be included with this report in the minutes. The November Financials were not included in December's minutes, and also missing was the YTD Group Contribution Report.
- The ledger balance and bank balances match for December. Starting in 2026 a line will be added onto the Financials showing the SINAC bank balance for the fellowship tracking now that the recent committee has dissolved.
- It is time to renew our SASC storage. I would like to propose that we pay a year in advance to lock in the monthly rent at \$242.80. Extra Space Storage, like Public Storage are Real Estate Companies now and they will only lock in pricing for 6 months. The average increase has been about \$80.00+ dollars a month every 6 months. To correct that we are then forced to move to get a "better" rate. Paying in advance could save the fellowship \$540.00 minimum in 2026.
- As soon as can be arranged SINAC supplies will be moved to the SASC storage unit. They are now in the outgoing Chair's garage.
