- A logo and slogan contest will be held, with submissions due by August 1st (prize: merchandise).
- New event ideas include a Spiritual Breakfast, Gratitude Dinner (Thanksgiving), and Marathon (Christmas time).

- We decided to pay for our rent for the entire year at Ronald United Methodist, coming to a total of \$240 on top of the \$20 we paid for May.
