The Unity Day Committee met on April 20, 2026, with approximately 14 members in Attendance.

Old Business included establishing committee structure and expectations, including monthly chair meetings, subcommittee development, and a two-year commitment for trusted servant positions. The committee also discussed creating a working timeline for future Unity Day committees and continuing to fill open positions.

New Business focused on finalizing committee roles, with several key positions now filled (Merchandise, Hospitality, Programming, and Food). The committee is currently

securing a regular meeting location, with quotes being gathered from multiple venues. Planning for the 4th of July Picnic is underway. The park has been reserved, and the committee is working on obtaining the necessary permit, rentals (BBQs, tables, coolers), and supplies. A flyer will be created outlining participation and contributions, and fundraising options such as raffles are being considered.

Initial discussions were held for the 2027 Sponsorship Dinner (tentatively January 30, 2027) and the 2027 Unity Day main event (tentatively April 3, 2027), with potential venues being explored.

Additional event ideas were discussed, including a Spiritual Breakfast, Gratitude Dinner, and holiday marathon events. A proposed budget for the 4th of July Picnic is in Development.

The next Unity Day Committee meeting is scheduled for May 18, 2026.

They had an emergency meeting to file relevant police reports, and will work to be included in the bankruptcy lawsuit against Shiloh. I will share more details about this as I learn them.
